Access appointment service

INCLUSION-EXCLUSION CRITERIA

The Access Appointment Service supports members and their patients who need to see a family physician within 24 hours but cannot see their physician. These criteria are not exhaustive but are intended to assist physician members and any staff who refer on their behalf make appropriate referrals to the service. This document was informed by physician members who work at the Primary Care Centre and the CWC PCN's Medical Director. It lists common appropriate (inclusion) and inappropriate (exclusion) reasons for referral.
