	EHCW's Manager records relevant information, begins investigation and advises EHCW on next steps.1
	Manager informs their Director of incident.
	Director informs Medical Director of incident.
	Manager, Director and Medical Director follow-up to ensure safety and well-being of EHCW, review and revise protocols as needed.
